

- That the enrolment in section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the class room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. The number of the existing sections should not exceed the number of classrooms of proper size in the school.
- That the school shall not run any pre-primary and unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place. Nursery class be removed from the premises of the school, if any. And no branch of this school shall be run under the banner of the recognised school.
10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.
 11. That the scheme of management shall be got approved from the Department immediately.
 12. That service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
 13. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 & 51 of the D & E R 1973, shall be made available to the students. Provision of Rules 6, 7 and 9 be strictly observed.
 14. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local body within a month.
 15. That the management of the school shall create a reserve fund of Rs. 5,000/- (Rs. Five thousand only) in a joint account in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the School in any Scheduled bank within a month.
 16. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school. That class IX shall not be added to the school without the prior permission of the Director of Education, Delhi.

- 17. That the management of the school will construct a suitable building on the land allotted by the DDE as per the specification of the Department and the school will be shifted to the new site within a period of 2 years with the approval of the Department.
- 18. That no development fee shall be charged from the students.
- 19. That all the F.Ds must be renewed for a period of Five Years.
- 20. That the number of students in two class-rooms shall be restricted from 25 to 45 and in six class-rooms 20 students as well.



In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loans/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
- The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
- The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
- The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
- The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of** for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
- The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.
